KNIT A POPPY

Make a poppy for Remembrance Day with this pattern

YOU WILL NEED

- Any red DK yarn
- A pair of 4mm (US 6) needles
- A small black button

TENSION

Not important for this project

POPPY

Cast on 60 sts using 4mm needles and red DK yarn.

Rows 1-8 (K2, P2) to end.

Row 9 (K2tog) to end. [30 sts]

Row 10 (S2kpo) to end. [10 sts]

Break off yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining 10 sts and pull tight, then fasten off yarn.

Join the edges of the poppy together and sew the black button in the centre of the poppy.

CROCHET A POPPY

Small amount of Red WW yarn Small amount of Black WW yarn

3.5 mm hook or larger for a bigger poppy

With Black yarn

R1: ch1, 7sc in a magic circle.

Cut yarn and sew in last sc to join round, creating the 8th stitch

With red yarn

R2: ss in anysc, ch3, 3tr in same st, 3tr in next st, ch3, ss in same st as last 3tr, (1 petal done),

* ch4, 3tr in same st, 3tr in next st, ch3, ss in same st as last 3tr, rep from * 2X ~ 4 petals in total
